
My Going to School Book



Now that I'm a big kid, I'm ready to go to school.




The night before school I help pack my backpack with all the things I'll need, and I get a good night's sleep.

This is what my school looks like.




It's called The Learning Tree.

of the time,


but when I get to school, they look like this. They're wearing masks because they care about me too and want me to stay healthy.

If I'm feeling a little sad, I remember that my grown-ups always come back, and I'll see them soon.


Inside, Mrs. Wheeler and Mrs. Marchese are waiting for me with my friends.
